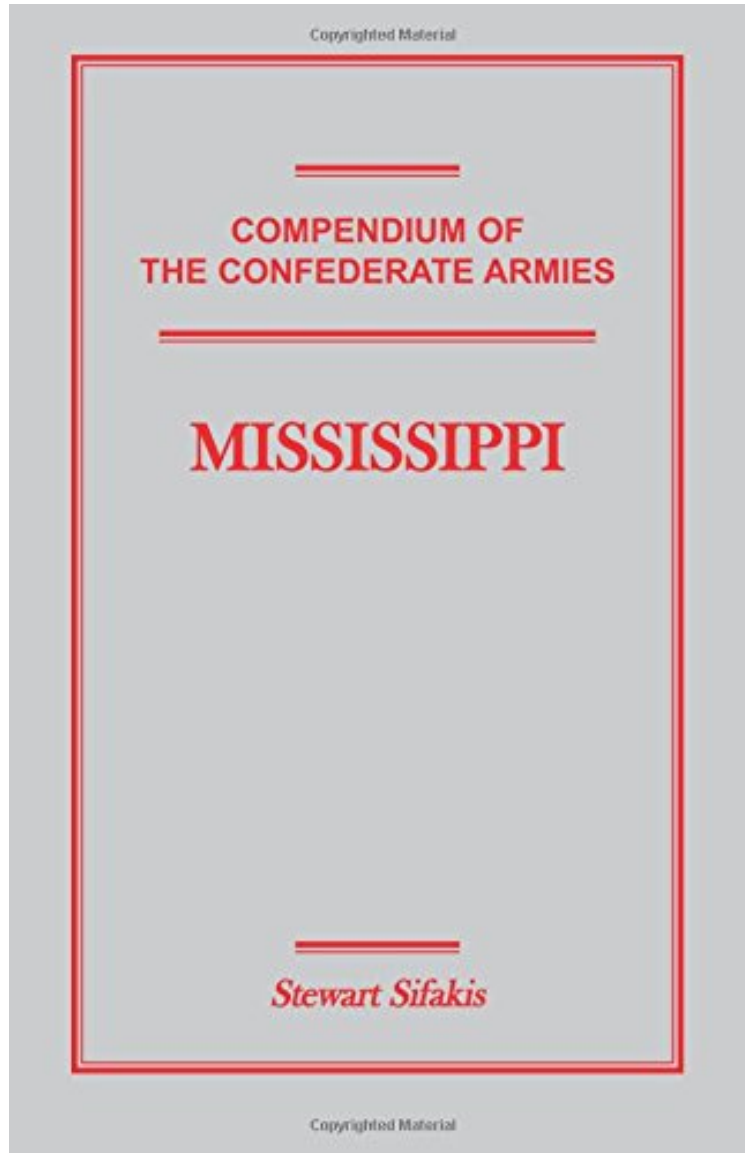

It is quite interesting as unit names morphed numerous times during the war. Unfortunately a little actual unit history, other than actions present at and units assigned to, would have helped, (also would have made it somewhat readable). Still it is interesting as a basic tool, whether the information is

totally true is a question, due to the obvious stresses the units underwent. Personally I would have arranged it differently as it is confusing to have battalion data precede regimental followed by battalion and occasionally named units (rather than numbered). Still without it, you could miss a lot of unit information when reading actual battle accounts. Recommended for referencing. Thanks, Harry!
