FalknorThis is a first hand account by John Alexander, a teenager in Winchester Virginia who, during the early years of the Civil War, could not resist swiping a horse belonging to a group of Union cavalry who were relaxing by a creek. Although he rode home safely through occupied Winchester with the horse, his grandmother declared that the only way to protect him from Union wrath was to have him take the horse on and join Mosby's Rangers. The narrative covers some of the skirmishing and raids at the Potomac crossing points (Point of Rocks, for example). It also tells about courtship between the young raiders and the young daughters of the Confederate-sympathetic farmers who sheltered and fed them.
