ExcellentBy Jim HNeVins covers the first year of the war from a unique persepective. It is less about the military battles and more "behind the scenes". He covers mustering and training of the armies, the buying of weapons, ammo and supplies, outfitting a navy (north and south), the need to learn organization skills on a large scale, the beginning of the transition in the north from small businesses and farms to larger, more coordinated enterprises, and other activities in Washington, Richmond and the States. These details are interesting in their own right and do a lot to explain the military activity covered in the more typical books on the war. Highly recommended to a civil war enthusiast.
