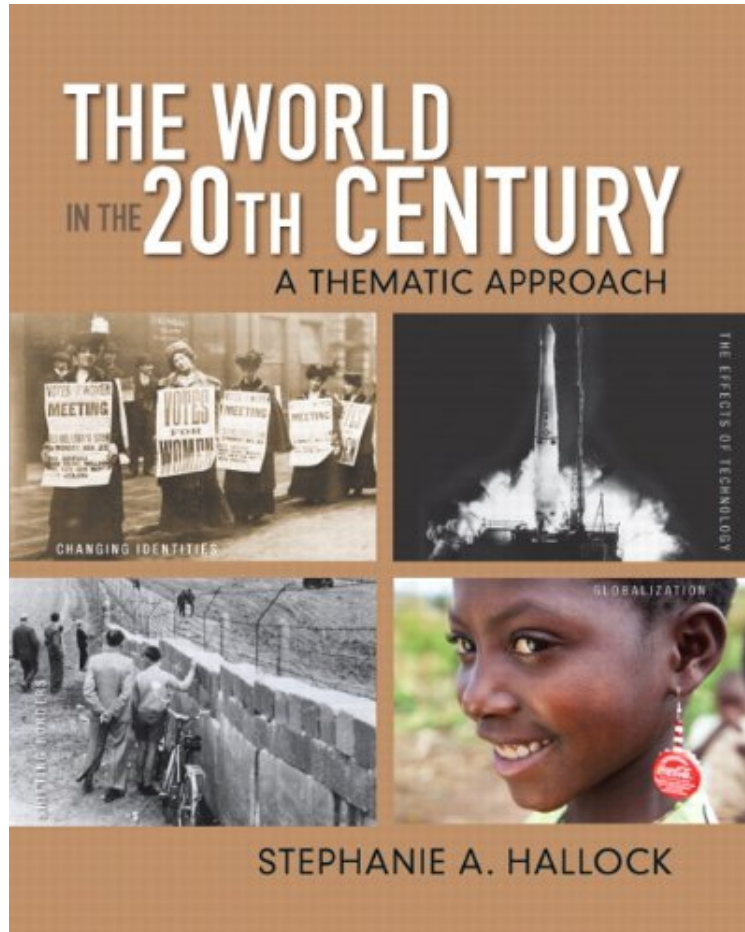


The World in the 20th Century: A Thematic Approach
