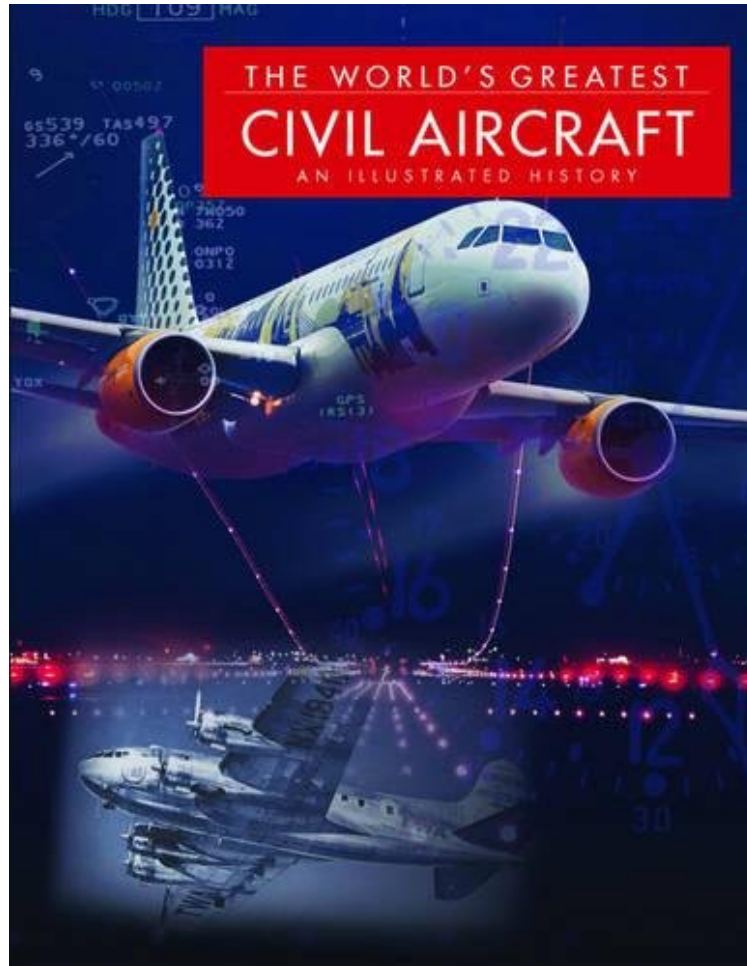

Commercial air travel began just over a century ago.
